The pricing for the agreements is as follows:

3 - Residents Printed*	€62.50	€94
4 - Residents Online*	€37.50	€62.50

\* Individual members can receive the hard copy version of European Urology for an additional annual fee of 100 Euros.

In order to benefit from an en-bloc agreement the national society is required to provide the EAU with a list of names of all its members. Furthermore the national society will bring at least 80% of its members into the EAU. This is excluding the senior urologists and the non-urologists.

The payment of the EAU membership fees should be executed by the national society, not by each member personally.
